Focus: The connection between environmental issues and management accounting in terms of the internal and external influence and measurement is an area under development. In addition, the development of a more ecological economic view in line with business and society's agenda for sustainable development.

Scope: Of particular interest are papers touching on the following areas: any empirical papers in organizational contexts looking at economic, environmental and ecological developments; conceptual papers providing analysis of economic concepts from a more ecological perspective; any papers tackling pedagogical issues in the area of environmental management accounting and sustainable development.

Purpose: To further develop EMA in terms of discourse on issues that are still very open and opaque, including: organizational control (EMA) and environmental output control; the measurement of EMA factors; and economic and environmental accounting tensions.
