This prize will be awarded to one young investigator in recognition of their expertise in the field of symmetry/asymmetry phenomena in natural sciences. All nominations will be assessed by the Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Sergei Odintsov.

### **The Prize**

- CHF 2000;
- Opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in *Symmetry* following peer review before the end of 2025;
- An electronic certificate.

### **Eligibility and Requirements**

- Must have completed their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2024;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of research on symmetry/asymmetry phenomena;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

### **List of Documents for Nomination**

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

### **Schedule**

- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2024
- Winner announcement: 31 March 2025
