Although it is mostly preventable and curable, approximately 10 million people develop tuberculosis disease, resulting in a million deaths every year globally. For the first time in several decades, we are on the brink of having a shorter treatment regimen for the treatment of drug-sensitive TB (DS-TB) and a novel TB vaccine that would prevent TB disease in adults.

As we look forward to TB elimination and meeting TB goals, evidence-based approaches would be the key. This Special Issue on “Holistic Approach to Tuberculosis Detection, Treatment and Prevention, Volume II” invites submissions on evidence-based approaches to ending TB, including active case-finding approaches, TB preventive treatment, and a holistic biosocial approach to TB elimination with global relevance.
