Dr. Komali Kantamaneni will present her work entitled "Proposed Topic: Coastal Water Vulnerability in Andhra Pradesh, India" at WRE 2019 (The 5th International Conference on Water Resource and Environment), to be held on 16–19 July 2019 in Macao, China.
