Advanced oxidation technology is considered one of the most effective methods for degrading ECs, and catalytic technology can significantly enhance the reaction speed of catalytic oxidation. Therefore, the development of highly active catalysts has become a key factor in improving the effective removal of ECs in water. Single-atom catalysts (SACs) have attracted widespread attention in the field of heterogeneous catalysis due to their maximum atomic utilization efficiency, stable performance, and low susceptibility to environmental interference. Numerous studies have shown that SACs have significant catalytic degradation effects on ECs.
